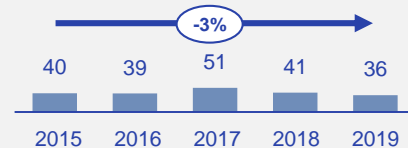

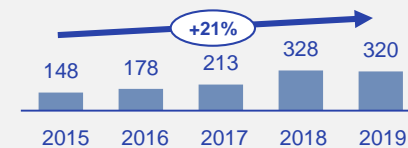

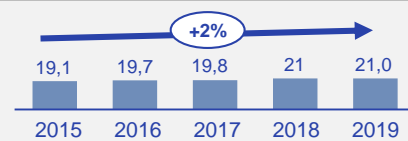
#### Morocco Imports (Mns MAD)



#### CEDEAO Imports (Mns MAD)



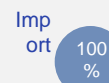
#### Europe Imports (Mns MAD)
