


Project #18: Production unit for sterilised ready meals



1 Product Complexity Index: Diversity and sophistication of the know-how required to produce a product. The PCI is calculated according to the number of countries producing the product and the economic complexity of these countries. The most complex products, those that only a few countries can produce, have the highest PCI (e.g. electronics, chemicals) vs. the least complex products (e.g. raw materials, agricultural products).

HS code: Economic complexity: 1902, 2104 / Trademap (World export values): 1902 (Pasta, whether or not cooked or stuffed with meat or other substances, or otherwise prepared, such as spaghetti, macaroni, noodles, lasagne, gnocchi, ravioli, cannelloni; couscous, whether or not prepared), 2104 (Preparations for soups or broths; prepared soups or broths; homogenized composite food preparations consisting of a finely homogenized mixture of several basic substances, such as meat, fish, vegetables, fruit, put up for retail sale as infant food or for dietetic purposes, in containers of <= 250 g)
