Key facts

- Tofu (soya cheese) is a food made by curdling soya milk it is an important staple of Asian and vegetarian diets - and comes in many forms (dried, smoked, fried, in sheets or blocks, hairy, silky, with herbs, etc.).
- Tofu is produced in a number of simple stages: preparation of soya milk (based on soya beans, water and heat treatment), addition of a coagulating agent (usually salt - e.g. magnesium or calcium chloride), pressing of the tofu, and pasteurisation and packaging.
- A niche product that is booming internationally, imported in its entirety into Morocco, and responding to a shift in consumer habits towards organic and plant-based food.
